Module Name: Digital Content Creation	
Topic Title: Cloud-Based Content Creation	
Lesson Plan 2– Cloud-Based Content (Blog)- Introduction	
Duration: 60-70 mins	
Aim	This lesson aims to introduce students on how to create their own cloud-based content through an informal setting: a Personal Blog. It aims to help students develop an understanding of cloud content creation as a topic and enhance particular skills to communicate in a different way through not only creating content of audiovisual content but also publishing articles and blogs.

Main Activity	<p>1. Activity 1 Introduction (10 minutes)</p> <p>Before you start your lesson, do a brief brainstorming session on possible ways of developing cloud-based content in an informal setting: Initiate a discussion using the following questions:</p>

	<p>-Does anyone know what a blog is? -How about WordPress? -How do you think it works?</p> <p>2. Activity 2 (15 minutes)</p> <p>Moving on and continuing the discussion: -The use of creating cloud-based content through a personal blog ((PPT-Topic 2 Cloud-Based Content Creation: slide 12) -What is WordPress and how can your students can use it? (PPT-Topic 2 Cloud-Based Content Creation: slide 13 and 15)</p> <p>3. Activity 3 (30-35 minutes)</p> <p>According to the PPT-Topic 2 Cloud-Based Content Creation follow the slides 15-19 to explain further how to create cloud-based content in an informal setting through WordPress. Provide your students with the Handout (2)Introduction to Cloud-Based Content Creation (WordPress) and collaborate to create the first blog. The main idea of this activity is that the students will develop the skills and understand how to use this platform.</p> <p>4. Conclusion (5 minutes)</p> <p>Finish your lesson by forming a circle and ask your students how the process of creating a blog made them feel.</p>
