Lesson Plan 2 – The concept of Fake News and how to evaluate and identify it	
Duration: 45 – 60 minutes	
Aim	This lesson aims to introduce students to the concept of Fake News, how to evaluate and identify it.

Main Activity	<p>1. Activity 1: Start the lesson with a video - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=V4o0B6IDo50 (3.5 mins)</p> <p>Encourage students to discuss the video by asking the following questions: (10 mins)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What is Fake News? - What is the harm in spreading fake news? <p>2. Activity 2: Share the Module4_NCSRD_Handout_1_Fake News with your students and ask them if the article is fake and why. (15 mins)</p> <p>3. Activity 3: Present and discuss with students a variety of ways to evaluate and identify if an article or photo is fake news. (20 mins)</p>
