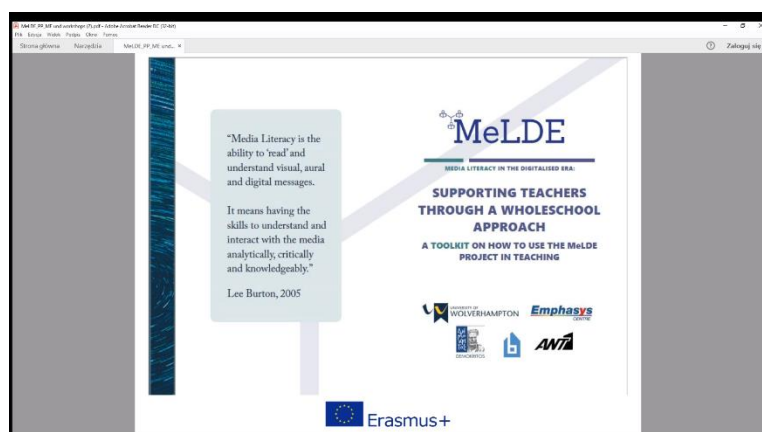
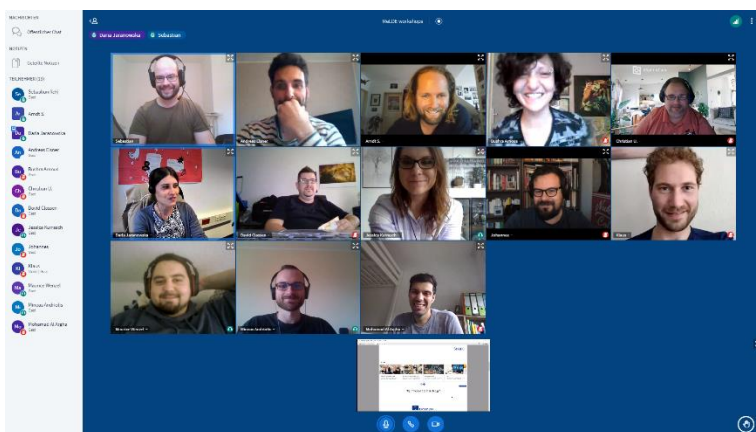
Presentation and Dissemination of the European Programme Media Literacy in the Digitalised Era (MeLDE): Supporting Teachers through a whole-school approach

MELDE is an Erasmus+ project which aims to strengthen Secondary School teachers' competences in order to support, protect and educate their students with regards to media literacy skills. The pilot testing phase in Germany took place at the end of June 2021 and conducted online due to restrictions imposed by the COVID-19.

The participants of the training had different backgrounds – teachers, freelancing teachers, trainers, artists teaching online. After a presentation of MeLDE project, a discussion was followed about digital classrooms. All of them had positive as well as negative experiences. Suddenly teachers needed to become digitally advanced trainers who not only share their knowledge with students but also entertain them – as keeping the attention online is more difficult than face to face. The participants were asking us for practical solutions and examples. After a presentation of different possibilities, a presentation of the MeLDE e-learning platform and material followed. The e-safety module was analysed more extensively, so that the participants will learn more about copyright issues.
