Lesson Plan 1 – The difference between a genuine and a copycat website	
Duration: 45 – 60 minutes

Activity 1: Start the lesson with a video <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-ZnmqvM4yyk (8 mins) <p>Encourage students to discuss the video by asking the following questions: (10 mins)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can you explain how easy is it to clone a website? - What are the risks of cloning a website? <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Activity 2: Introduce differences between a genuine and a copycat website (30 mins) <p>Activity 2.1: Present to students the copycat websites on this page: https://legalbeagles.info/forums/forum/legal-forums/scams-fraud-it/copycat-unofficial-third-party-website-issues/96338-example-copycat-and-third-party-websites and ask them what are the signs that give these websites away.</p>
