Lesson Plan 2 – Threats to Data and Information & Reporting Internet Scammers	
Duration: 45 – 60 minutes	
Aim	This lesson aims to introduce students to the concept of threats to data and information and inform them about the ways of reporting internet scammers.

Main Activity	<p>1. Activity 1: Start the lesson with a video</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=AuYNXgO_f3Y (5 mins) <p>Discussion questions for the video: (10 mins)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What do you understand by Cybersecurity and Cybercrime? <p>Continue the lesson with a second video</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kDFeSUUwRnA (2.5 mins) <p>Discussion questions for the video: (10 mins)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - How would you describe Identity Theft? <p>2. Activity 2: Introduce potential threats to data and information (20 mins)</p>

	<p>2.1 Activity: Provide your students with sticky-notes and ask them to provide answers to the following and then discuss it with the whole class:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - List/describe 3-4 potential threats to data. - List/describe 3-4 potential threats to information. <p>2.2 Present students with a description of the various main threats to data and information.</p> <p>3. Activity 3: Introduce ways of reporting internet scammers (15 mins)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Present students with ways of reporting internet scammers. - Ask them if they are confident about using the aforementioned ways to report a potential scam. <p>4. Wrap it up (5 mins)</p>
