Topic Title: Protecting personal data	
Lesson Plan 3 – Malicious Emails & Malicious Links	
Duration: 45 – 60 minutes	
Aim	This lesson aims to introduce students to ways to recognize malicious emails, malicious links and what to do if you accidentally click on a malicious link.

Main Activity	<p>1. Activity 1: Recognize malicious emails</p> <p>Activity 1.1: Play a video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=U7tbJVSInvo (5 mins)</p> <p>Activity 1.2: Encourage students to discuss the video (10 mins) by asking the following questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - What do you think are the risks behind malicious emails? - Has anyone ever clicked on a malicious link in an email? What happened next? <p>Activity 1.3: Give a presentation on the he ways malicious emails can be recognised (20 mins)</p> <p>2. Activity 2: Recognize malicious links</p> <p>Activity 2.1: Play a video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=BcoHrDt-v_4 (4 mins)</p>

	<p>Activity 2.2: Provide your students with sticky-notes and ask them to give examples of what they would do if they thought a link they clicked on is malicious.</p> <p>Activity 2.3: Tell students the actions they should take if they suspect they have clicked on a malicious link.</p> <p>3. Wrap it up (5 mins)</p>
