<b>Module Name: E-Safety</b>	
<b>Topic Title: Digital Copyright</b>	
<b>Lesson Plan 3 - Open Access Sources</b>	
<b>Duration: 60 min</b>	
<b>Aim</b>	This lesson aims to explore a series of open access resources and assist students' understanding of what and when digital content can be used and re-used for educational purposes.
<b>Target Group</b>	Secondary School students
<b>Facility/ Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Classroom</li> <li>➤ Laptop or a computer</li> <li>➤ Internet access</li> <li>➤ Projector or a whiteboard</li> <li>➤ Students' mobile phones</li> </ul>
<b>Tools/ Materials</b>	➤ <b>Handouts (<i>Topics_open_access_sources</i>)</b>
<b>Main Activity</b>	<p><b>1. Activity 1 (20 min)</b> The teacher provides students with the definition of "open access sources" and gives examples of such sources: Wikicommons, Flickr, Free Music Archive, Incompetech, DeviantART, You Tube, Unsplash and Google (search: not filtered by license).</p> <p><b>2. Activity 2. - 20 min</b> Ask students to work in groups of 3 to collect information about a topic by using only 3 open access sources discussed in the previous activity. The teacher monitors, answers question and helps the students.</p> <p><b>3. Activity 3. - 10 min</b> Ask each student group to present the outcome of their work. Encourage their peers to give them feedback. The teacher supports students and adds any important information not already mentioned by the students.</p> <p><b>4. Wrap up</b></p>

**Assessment****1. Assessment 1 (10 min)**

The teacher projects 5 statements about open access sources on [kahoot.com](https://kahoot.com). The students need to decide if they are true or false. The teacher shows the correct answers. After all, 5 statements, the teachers show the students 'results.
