Topic Title: Technology-Enabled Citizenship	
Lesson Plan 3 – What Does “Active Digital Citizen” Mean?	
Duration: 60 min	
Aim	This lesson aims to show how digital technology can be used to empower students and encourage them to become active citizens.
Target Group	Secondary School students

Main Activity	<p>1. Activity 1 (15 min) The teacher shows students how they can be active digital citizens by presenting the following examples: Vote Compass, Simulated Election, Ask Your Politician, Watch Sites, Livestream from Parliament, Digital Initiatives.</p> <p>2. Activity 2 (25 min) Students work in groups of 3. The task is to present a topic which could be used by them as a digital initiative. The teacher monitors, answers question and helps the students.</p> <p>3. Activity 3 (10 min) The groups present the outcome of their work. The others give feedback. The teacher supports students’ ideas, and adds important information not already mentioned by the students.</p> <p>4. Wrap up</p>

Assessment	<p>1. Assessment 1 (10 min)</p> <p>The teacher projects 5 statements about active digital citizen on kahoot.com. The students need to decide if they are true or false. The teacher shows the correct answers.
